The C-Res team works closely with the crew at BHP WAIO Operations to provide LBP Awareness and How To Sessions to help support sustainable diversity, and expand local and indigenous procurement opportunities in the communities BHP operates in. The introduction of BHP Southflank into the LBP, combined with more regular engagement with site project teams and key BHP personnel, has resulted in increased opportunities for suppliers in Western Australia.

Regular Drop-In Sessions have been provided for all stakeholders (BHP, suppliers and community groups) in Newman and Port Hedland. We continue to work closely with the BHP Principal, Local Buying to source opportunities for Traditional Owner and Pilbara Aboriginal Businesses, and with the BHP Supply Business Partner in Newman and Port Operations to build meaningful engagement between BHP personnel and LBP suppliers.
