Who Can Participate

Businesses are required to meet a number of minimum mandatory qualification criteria prior to being assessed and approved as a 'Local Buying' supplier by C-Res.

This criteria includes:

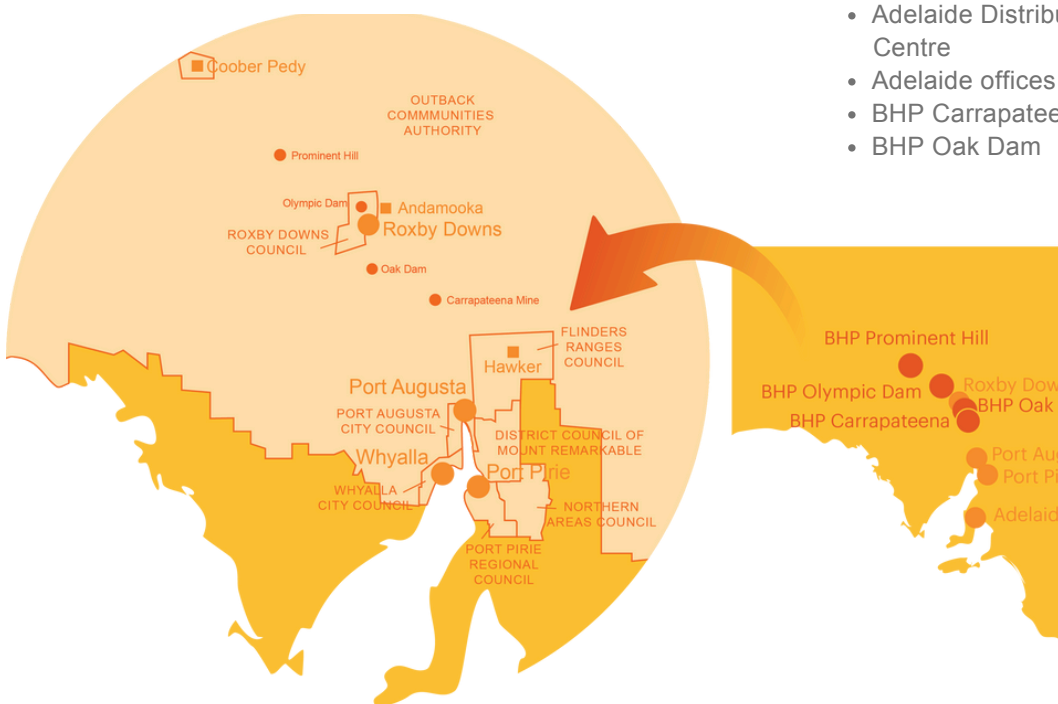
- an annual turnover of <AUD\$10M
- a significant physical presence in an eligible Local Buying Program region
- an ABN and be registered for GST (if required)
- appropriate insurances including Workers Compensation (if an Employer) and Public Liability

Eligible Regions

To register for, and then work with the Local Buying Program in South Australia, suppliers must have a significant physical presence in the local government councils of Coober Pedy, Port Augusta, Port Pirie, Mount Remarkable, Northern Areas, Flinders Ranges, Outback Communities Authority, Whyalla and Roxby Downs.

All South Australian operations, including operational, rehabilitation and project sites, are able to engage suppliers through the Local Buying Program. This currently includes

- BHP Carrapateena
- BHP Oak Dam
- BHP Olympic Dam
- BHP Prominent Hill
- Integrated Operations Projects

Both the Foundation and the Program are administered by C-Res, operating in local regions across New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia where BHP operates

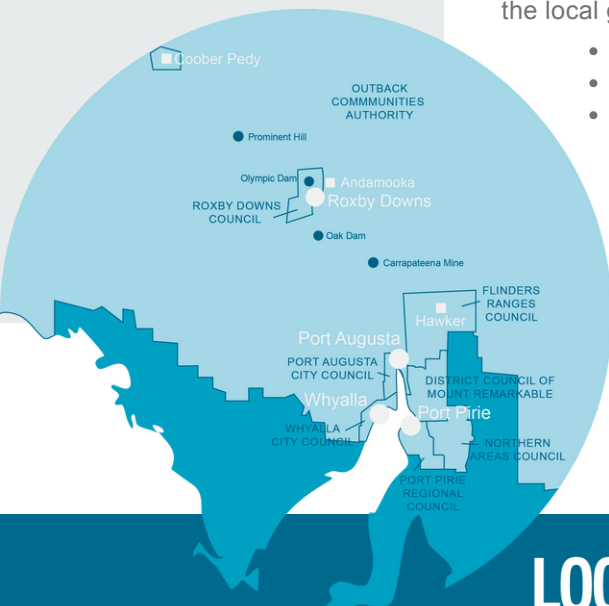
What has the Foundation funded?
