Who Can Participate

Businesses are required to meet a number of minimum mandatory qualification criteria prior to being assessed and approved as a 'Local Buying' supplier by C-Res.

This criteria includes:

- an annual turnover of <AUD\$10M
- a significant physical presence in an eligible Local Buying Program region
- an ABN and be registered for GST (if required)
- appropriate insurances including Workers Compensation (if an Employer) and Public Liability

Eligible Regions

To register for, and then work with the Local Buying Program in Queensland, suppliers must have a significant physical presence in a local government area of Central Highlands, Isaac or Mackay.

All BMA operations, including operational, rehabilitation and project sites, are able to engage suppliers through the Local Buying Program. These include:
