About the Local Buying Program

The Local Buying Program provides one clear path for suppliers to provide goods and services to BHP and has been established to support small, local and Indigenous Businesses in their engagements with BHP Western Australian Iron Ore (WAIO).

The Program is delivered in a strategic partnership between BHP and C-Res – a cost neutral entity - across all BHP Minerals Australia Assets.

Who Can Participate

Businesses are required to meet a number of minimum mandatory qualification criteria prior to being assessed and approved as a 'Local Buying' supplier by C-Res.

This criteria includes:

- an annual turnover of <AUD\$10M
- a significant physical presence in an eligible Local Buying Program region
- an ABN and be registered for GST (if required)
- appropriate insurances including Workers Compensation (if an Employer) and Public Liability

Eligible Regions

To register for, and then work with the Local Buying Program in Western Australia, suppliers must have a significant physical presence in a local government area which includes the Town of Port Hedland and the shires of Ashburton and East Pilbara.

The objective of the Local Buying Foundation is to enhance the economic stability across the communities where BHP and the Local Buying Foundation operates, building sustainable business communities for the future.

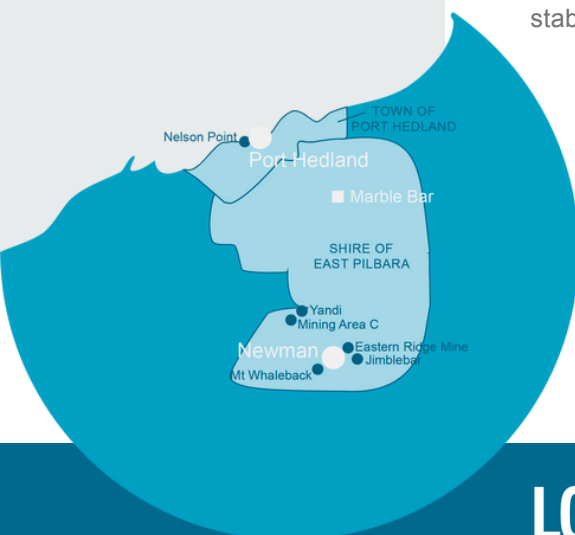
What has the Foundation funded?
