The Local Buying Program (LBP) provides opportunities for small businesses in the eligible regions of New South Wales, Queensland, South Australia and Western Australia to competitively supply goods and services to BHP, BHP Mitsubishi Alliance (BMA), BHP Mitsui Coal (BMC) and BHP Operations Services. The LBP commenced in Queensland 2012 and expanded into New South Wales in 2016, then South Australia and Western Australia in 2017, and is delivered in partnership between BHP and C-Res. C-Res, a cost neutral small business, delivers the LBP across all BHP Minerals Australia assets nationwide.
