BHP Tier A Contractor engages Suppliers via LBP

In October 2021, BHP's Tier A Contractor, CQ Field Mining Services, will be the first of several authorised contractors, including C-Res, to have access to the Local Buying Program portal to engage directly with approved LBP Suppliers.

What's exciting, is that CQ Field Mining Services will have access to the LBP supplier database which will open the door to new engagements for the supply of goods and services. LBP Supplier Profiles will be made visible to the Tier A Contractor to enable them to view Capability Statements and nominated Supply Categories. In addition to receiving work opportunities from BHP, LBP Suppliers will now have access to work opportunities raised by CQ Field Mining Services, and eventually other Tier A Contractors.

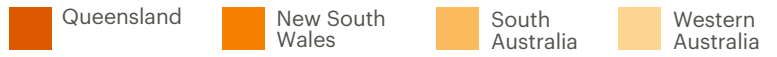

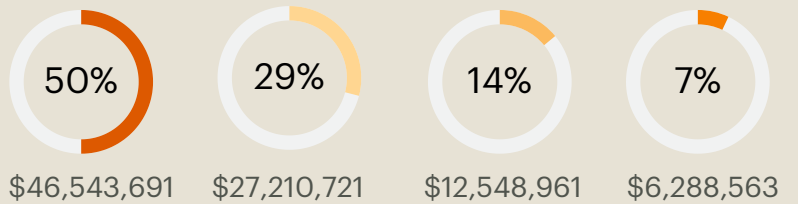

Our States - Legend



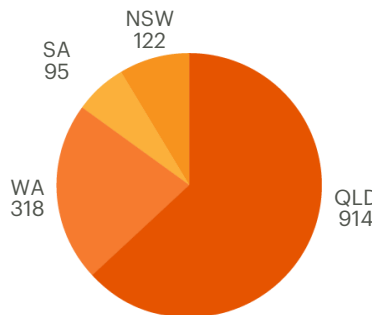
Actual Spend by State



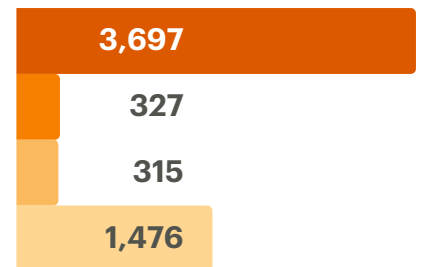

National Indigenous Business Support Program Update

The National Indigenous Business Support Program is nearing completion of the development stage, and the "Trading Tracks" program name and objectives have been successfully launched in Queensland.

Trading Tracks has been designed to build the capability and capacity of established Indigenous Businesses in the regions, including assisting new Indigenous Businesses, through a range of services.

Trading Tracks will be delivered in each state by a carefully selected service provider to ensure alignment with the collective values of all stakeholders, and their commitment to creating strong and resilient Indigenous Businesses.

BHP in Western Australia and South Australia have also committed to releasing Trading Tracks in the respective regions. Contracts are in the development phase, and expressions of interest for service providers will be released in due course.

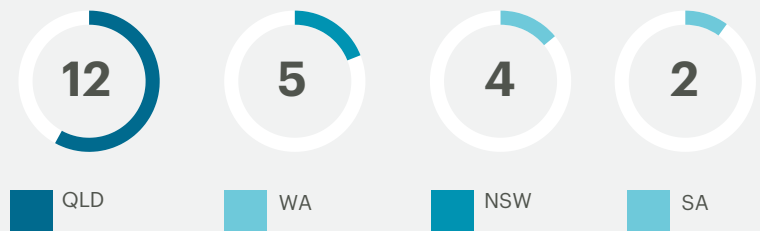
