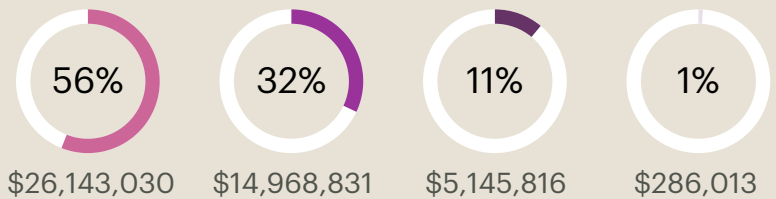

Our Regions - Legend



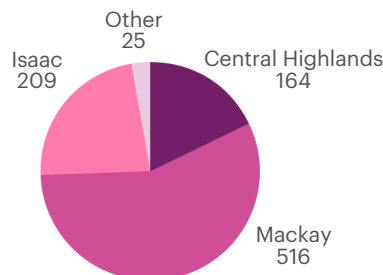
Actual Spend by Region



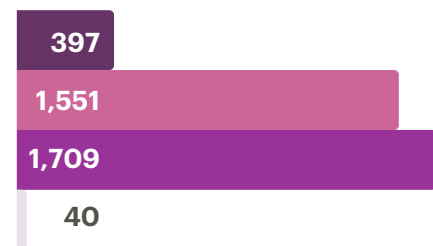

Indigenous Businesses to benefit from the launch of "Trading Tracks" Qld

The Local Buying Foundation, BHP and BMA announced Indigenous Business Builders as the selected service provider to deliver Trading Tracks Qld.

Indigenous Business Builders CEO, Brendan Bishop, is an Aboriginal man from the Kamilaroi people and has extensive experience in Indigenous business economic development.

This initial three-year pilot program will support Indigenous Businesses, through the delivery of a range of capacity and capability building services in Central Highlands, Isaac and Mackay regions, including the Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire Council.

Head of BMA Business Partnership, Jessica Simpson, said Trading Tracks was established to connect Traditional Owner and Indigenous Businesses with practical support and advice.
