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About the Program

The Program enables small local, and Indigenous businesses to easily engage with and competitively supply goods and services to BHP's Nickel West operations. These areas include Wiluna, Leonora, Kalgoorlie and Kambalda.

The Local Buying Program is delivered in a strategic partnership between BHP and C-Res – a cost neutral entity - across all BHP Minerals Australia Assets.

Who can participate in the Local Buying Program?

Businesses are required to meet a number of minimum mandatory qualification criteria prior to being assessed and approved as a 'Local Buying' supplier by C-Res. Criteria includes:

- Must be a business with an annual turnover of <AUD\$10M
- Must have a significant physical presence in an eligible Local Buying Program area
- Must have an ABN and be registered for GST (if required)
- Must have appropriate insurances including Workers Compensation (if an Employer) and Public Liability (mandatory)

Where the Program operates?

To register for, and then work with the Local Buying Program in Western Australia, suppliers must have a significant physical presence in one of the following shires:

- City of Kalgoorlie – Boulder
- Coolgardie Shire Council
- Shire of Leonora
- Shire of Wiluna
- Shire of Menzies

Nickel West operations, including operational, rehabilitation and project sites, are able to engage suppliers through the Local Buying Program. These include:

- Mt Keith Mine
- Leinster Mine
- Kalgoorlie Smelter
- Kambalda Concentrator
